Here are a list of key skills you can practise over the summer to help you prepare for Year 1. Your teacher will ask you to share this when you return in September:

<b>Reading</b>	<i>I have practised this:</i>
<i>I enjoy reading to an adult every day.</i>	
<i>I have practised listening carefully to stories an adult reads to me.</i>	
<i>I understand and talk about what I have read or has been read to me.</i>

<b>Writing</b>	<i>I have practised this:</i>
<i>I have practised writing all of my letters correctly so they are easy to read.</i>	
<i>I have practised remembering simple sentences said by an adult by holding them in my head.</i>	
<i>I enjoy writing for a reason like making a shopping list or a postcard.</i>

<b>Maths</b>	<i>I have practised this:</i>
<i>I have practised counting up to 20 things accurately, e.g. small toys, Lego bricks, stairs.</i>	
<i>I have practised reading numbers I see around me, e.g. house numbers, numbers on cars, signs.</i>	
<i>I have practised saying the 'teen' numbers and the 'ty' numbers with care, e.g. '14 and 40'.</i>	
<i>I have practised writing my numbers the correct way around.</i>
