Here are a list of key skills you can practise over the summer to help you prepare for Year 4. Your teacher will ask you to share this when you return in September:

<b>Reading</b>	<i>I have practised this:</i>
<i>I have practised reading fluently and focusing on understanding what I am reading rather than how to read the words.</i>	
<i>I have practised staying focused and reading to myself for 20 minutes.</i>	
<i>I can describe a character's thoughts and feelings based on their actions.</i>

<i>I have practised to spell most words taught in Year 3 in my own writing (see Spelling Frame website).</i>

<i>I have practised answering 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times table facts quickly.</i>
