Covid update:

As some of you may be aware some other local schools have had to close class bubbles. I just want to clarify to you some of the guidance from Public Health England should they ask a school to close a bubble:

- Remember that for the vast majority of people, coronavirus is a mild illness
- Parents and carers of all children in the bubble will be asked to collect their child and the children will be asked to isolate for 14 days.
- Unless a child develops symptoms, they will not need to have a test
- The rest of your household, including siblings do not need to isolate - unless anybody in the household develops symptoms.
- All other children in the school, including any siblings of children in the closed bubble, should continue to attend school.

I would like to thank all parents once again for your support at the start and end of each day. However, we have received some concerns from parents and neighbours regarding dangerous parking and parents congregating on the narrow pavements right outside the school. I know the guidelines we have to follow are inconvenient, however I would ask for your support with this, not only in terms of being considerate to others, but for the safety of our pupils near to the roads.
