



Ask permission

Acceptable Use of Technology Agreement Early Years and Key Stage 1



This agreement will help me to:

- Stay safe while using the internet and other digital technologies for education, and for fun.
- Use technology at home and at school both responsibly and safely.

To stay safe when using computers at school and at home:

- I will ask an adult if I want to use a computer or device.
- I will only use a computers or device when an adult is with me.
- I will be kind to others online when I am sending messages.
- I will keep information about me safe, including my password.
- I will ask for help from an adult if I am not sure what to do, or if I think I have made a mistake.
- I will tell an adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen, or if I am worried.
- I will only use activities that an adult has allowed me to use.
- I know that if I break these rules, I might not be allowed to use the computers and devices.

Remote learning:

- I will make sure that I use my computer or device in a sensible place (not in my bedroom).
- I will have an adult close by me when I am in a 'live lesson'.
- I will only do activities online that a teacher or suitable adult has told me or allowed me to use.
