## Topic Guide Term 5



### Religious Education

This term in R.E our topic is **Christianity - Gospel**. By the end of the term, the children will be able to answer the question:

*What is the good news Jesus brings?*

- Tell stories from the Bible and recognise a link with a concept of 'Gospel' or good news.
- Give clear, simple accounts of what Bible texts (such as the story of Matthew the tax collector) mean to Christians.
- Recognise that Jesus gives instructions to people about how to behave.
- Give at least two examples of ways in which Christians follow the teachings studied about forgiveness and peace, and bringing good news to the friendless.

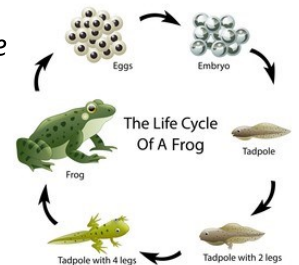


### Science

In Science, we will be focusing on animals including humans. By the end of the term, the children will:

- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into humans.
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

We will be exploring the life cycle of humans, frogs, butterflies and dragonflies.



### Computing

In computing, we will start our topic on programming. To do this, we will be using the application Scratch Jr. The children will be using codes to create their own animations, follow algorithms, use codes and create their own algorithms.



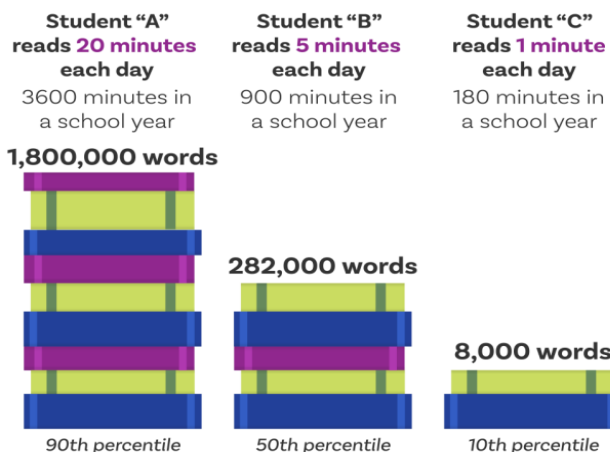
# HOME LEARNING

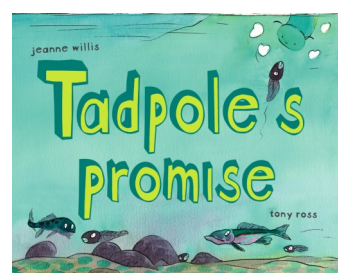
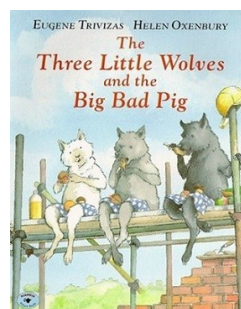
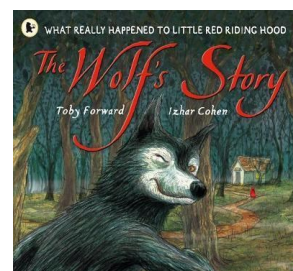


# P.E
